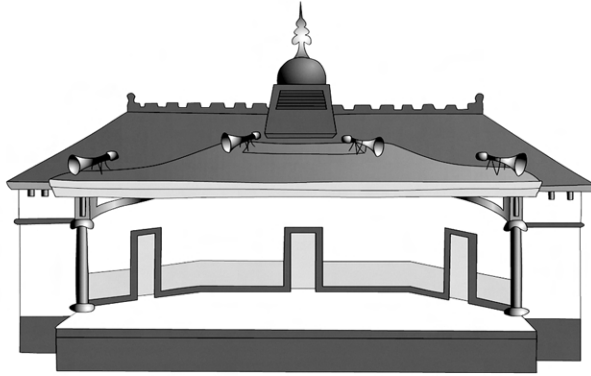




Bandstand Restoration



Designed and built by Glasgow's own Parks Department in the 1920's, Kelvingrove Bandstand is now the only free-standing theatre-style bandstand with oval amphitheatre in Scotland, and is therefore of great Heritage and Cultural significance.

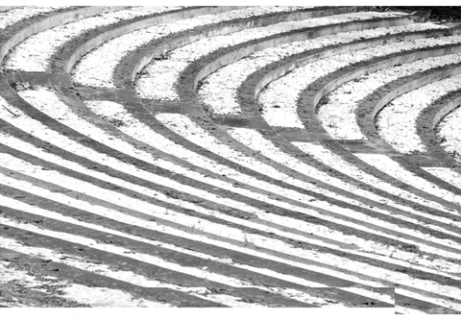

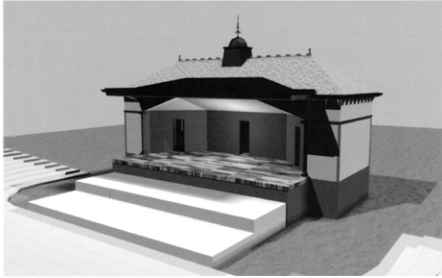

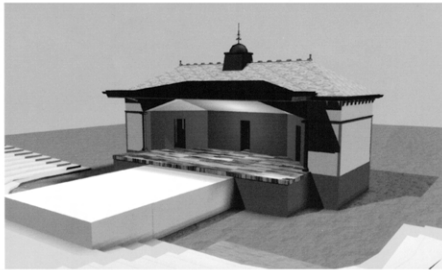




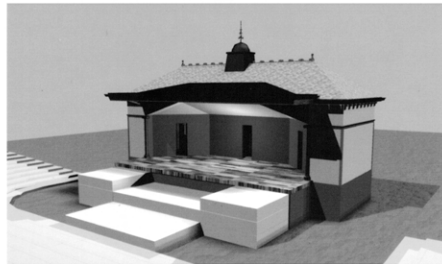

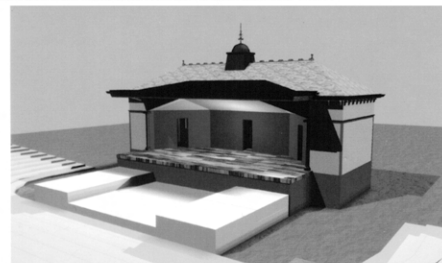
Flexible Staging - Choral Arrangement
